



The two-day seminar is focused on the methods of web-based international cooperation in kindergartens and primary schools. At the seminar you will learn more about involving pupils into the project-based learning and international cooperation with the help of eTwinning. In the workshops, you will learn step-by-step how to make an international project that can be implemented immediately in your kindergarten or school. The seminar provides a good opportunity to make new contacts with other teachers at European level.

Teachers who are teaching children from 5-10 years will participate in the seminar.

In addition, you will also discover the topic of media literacy and learn how to discuss it with smaller children. You will get practical tips and tricks using smartphones for making pictures and lots of good ideas for using simple web-based tools as well as pedagogical techniques and active learning methods.

The working language of the seminar will be English. Seminar will be organized online, using eTwinning tools as well as Zoom.
