<b>Themes and goals:</b>	This training seminar equips participants with essential knowledge and tools to recognize and address barriers in Erasmus+ mobility projects (KA1) in VET, focusing on engaging diverse target groups and providing effective support throughout the mobility experience. Key topics include identifying participation barriers, strategies for engaging diverse learners, preparation and support, and effective mentoring practices. Through a practical, hands-on approach that includes group work and peer learning, participants will share and explore best practices. Expert-led sessions on diversity will provide valuable insights, equipping participants to implement inclusive approaches in their future Erasmus+ mobility initiatives.
<b>Expected results:</b>	Enhanced Awareness of the barriers diverse learners face in Erasmus+ VET mobility projects. Practical Strategies and Tools to effectively engage and support underrepresented groups and diverse learners, promoting inclusion and participation. Implementation Tools for participants to apply inclusive practices in their future Erasmus+ VET mobility initiatives. Established Connections with potential project partners, emphasizing collaboration on group mobility in Erasmus+ VET.
