Plenary inputs will be complemented by field-based and multi-field groupwork and exchanges, through an action-based learning approach. Activities: During this event, participants will be prompted to consider needs from a programme, field-based and multi-field perspective, reflecting on the scope, extent, quality and sufficiency of needs analysis in Erasmus+, on transnationality and proportionality, and on needs analysis methods and tools that are relevant to Erasmus+ and Cooperation Partnerships.

By the end of this exchange, partnership and capacity-building event, participants will be able to:RECOGNISE the expectations of Erasmus+ Cooperation Partnerships for proposals based on a genuine and adequate needs analysis;COMPARE insights and expectations across different educational fields, to determine the expected scope, extent, quality and sufficiency of needs analysis activity in Erasmus+;CREATE a credible and convincing needs analysis within future Erasmus funding applications, particularly within Key Action 2 Cooperation Partnerships.
